- 2 Recommendations (as per Common Application, please use GEO's Recommendation Forms)
  - the 1<sup>st</sup> Recommendation Form preferably from adviser or Committee Chair
  - the 2<sup>nd</sup> Recommendation Form from faculty who can specifically address your language ability and/or ability to do your anticipated coursework in France
- Possible interview in French to be arranged through the GEO (only for students wishing to take courses in French)

II. All application materials are due to the GEO on the Hampshire Exchange Deadline. Upon acceptance by the GEO you will be asked to do the following:

- Submit the electronic application from Sciences Po uploading resume, photo, and transcript
- Complete Sciences Po's online French proficiency placement test
- Complete the "Welcome Programme" registration form & deposit if choosing to participate in the program.
