### POINTS TO PONDER FOR SEPTEMBER

<u>Are you a 1<sup>st</sup> semester student</u>? If you have questions your advisor can't answer, please contact CASA, ext. 5498. <u>Are you a 2<sup>nd</sup> semester student</u>? Plan to finish all of your Div 1 requirements by the end of this semester. Are you a 3rd semester student? Have you finished your Div 1 requirements? No? Be sure to complete requirements this semester. If you have completed all requirements for Div 1, talk to your advisor to find out what they want included in the Div 1 portfolio. Start working on it and schedule a final meeting. This fall you will be required to participate in the Div 2 committee request process and will be assigned a Div 2 committee by mid October. Div 2 contracts will be signed in early February. Are you a 4<sup>th</sup> semester student? You really care about the September 23rd Div 2 filing deadline. Spend lots of time prior to this deadline finding a chair; make sure your chair AND your member 'sign' your contract on TheHub. If you have any questions or problems regarding Div 2, please make an appointment with Zena Clift or Karina Fernandez in CASA, ext. 5498. Mid October: Meet with your advisor to talk about course selection for Spring in order to be approved to preregister! Now's the time to talk about Division 2 plans, possible committees, academic progress, etc.

Please contact the <u>Center for</u> <u>Academic Support and Advising</u> (CASA) to begin the process. **If you are planning to go on field study or exchange, we recommend you still pre-register for courses this spring.** Thank you.

Be sure you have met your advisor to talk about planning courses for Spring semester. Why is this important? You will not be authorized to preregister without advisor approval on TheHub and you will be sad. Look for more info from Central Records.
