Registration form for Private Instrumental/Vocal Lessons

Use this form if you are taking lessons with an instructor who is not affiliated with one of the Five Colleges. Note that fees for lessons vary from \$750-\$800 for 12 one-hour lessons per semester. The fee will be added to your student account and the college will handle the payments to the instructor. If you discontinue the lessons, your account may be charged for all of the lessons. If you are a Division II or III music concentrator who is currently receiving a Hampshire financial aid, you may be eligible for a one-time music grant for private lessons. This grant only covers up to \$720. The student needs to accept the responsibility of pay the difference. You need to apply for this grant at the time of registration. Contact the financial aid office for details.

Please note that a music concentrator is defined as someone whose Div. II or Div. III committee includes a member of Hampshire's Music Program.

You will need to obtain prior approval from a member of Hampshire's music faculty and the instructor through the private music lesson coordinator of the school the instructor is affiliated with. If you are unsure who to contact, consult with the Hampshire music faculty.

The completed form should be returned to Central Records by the end of the course add/drop period for the semester you are taking the lessons. Although you may take lessons at any time during your academic career, please note the following:

- Private lessons bear 2 credits, and are not considered equivalent to Hampshire full-credit courses.
- They may not be used in place of one of the seven courses required in Division I.
- They may not be used as an Advanced Educational Activity in Division III.
- They may not be used in place of one of the academic courses required to maintain full-time enrollment.
