Please note that a music concentrator is defined as someone whose Div. II or Div. III committee includes a member of Hampshire's Music Program, and who studies music as a critical component of theie divisional work.

You will need to obtain prior approval from a member of Hampshire's music faculty and the instructor.

The completed form should be returned to Central Records by the end of the course add/drop period for the semester you are taking the lessons. Although you may take lessons at any time during your academic career, please note the following:

- Private lessons bear <u>2 credits</u>, and are not considered equivalent to Hampshire full-credit courses.
- They may not be used in place of one of the seven courses required in Division I.
- They may not be used as an Advanced Educational Activity in Division III.
- They may not be used in place of one of the academic courses required to maintain full-time enrollment.
