Are you a 7<sup>th</sup> semester student or transfer student ready to file Div 3? You **really** care about the October 8 Div 3 filing deadline. Spend lots of time prior to this deadline finding a chair; make sure your chair **AND** your member 'sign' your contract on TheHub.

	<u>Why do I care?</u> If you are not registered for a course, the faculty member <u>cannot</u> give you an evaluation (HC courses) or a grade (Five College courses). If you don't drop the courses you are not attending, you will receive an "F" or a "No evaluation" on your permanent transcript that <u>cannot</u> be removed.
