The deadline for passing Div 1 is **Friday, September 16.** This fall you will begin to draft your Div 2 proposal with the guidance of your advisor to assure you have a viable concentration in place. Contracts will be signed in early February. CASA is sponsoring workshops to help you through the Div 2 filing process. Check the dates below and mark your calendar.

Are you a 4th semester student? You **really** care about the September 30th Div 2 filing deadline. Spend lots of time <u>prior to this</u> deadline finding a chair; make sure your chair **AND** your member 'sign' your contract on TheHub.
