### *POINTS TO PONDER FOR FEBRUARY*

Are you a 7<sup>th</sup> semester student or transfer student ready to file Div 3? You **really** care about the February 19<sup>th</sup> Div 3 filing deadline. Spend lots of time prior to this deadline finding a chair; make sure your chair **AND** your member ‘sign’ your contract on TheHub.

Are you planning to **graduate** in December 2015? Be sure to pass Div 2 by February 12 and file Div 3 by February 19. If you have any questions or problems, please make an appointment with Anne Downes in CASA, ext. 5498.

February 3	Add/Drop Period Ends for Hampshire & Five College Courses	
<u>Why do I care?</u> If you are not registered for a course, the faculty member <u>cannot</u> give you an evaluation or a grade (Five College courses). If you don’t drop the courses you are not attending, you will receive an “F” or a “No evaluation” on your permanent transcript that <u>cannot</u> be removed.

*POINTS TO PONDER FOR APRIL*

Make sure you have a regular schedule of meeting with your Div 3 committee.

- April 1            Advising Day (no Hampshire classes)
- April 6            Pre-registration for Fall 2015 begins! See the Div 3 Guide for Students or the CASA webpage for Information about Advanced Activities
- April 10            \*\*\*Enrollment Notification Deadline\*\*\*  
Bring paperwork to CASA by this date if you think you will be away from campus (Leave, Field Study or Exchange) for Fall 2015.
- April 13            Last day to drop classes with a “W” (for withdrawn)  
I thought the add/drop deadline passed?  
It did. This is the last day to drop a class and not receive a “No Eval” for Hampshire courses or an “F” for 5 College courses on your official transcript.
- April 17            5-College preregistration ends
- April 27            Hampshire preregistration ends
- April 27            Last Day of Classes – Mount Holyoke
- April 29            Last day of classes – UMass

- May 1            Last day of classes – Smith
- May 1            Last day of classes – Hampshire

Course Evals are due June 15.

Be sure to check TheHub after this deadline to be sure you have evals for all the courses you are expecting evals from. Follow up with your faculty if you do not see the eval posted. Satisfactory Academic Progress is determined at this time which may affect academic standing and financial aid eligibility.
