

MISSING RECEIPT AFFIDAVIT

When a receipt is lost or otherwise unavailable and all measures to obtain a copy have been exhausted, the Missing Receipt Affidavit should be completed. It should be signed by the employee and the employee's supervisor and submitted with the employee's reimbursement request, unless the transaction was placed on an employee's Procurement card. In the case of a Procurement card transaction, the Missing Receipt Affidavit should be submitted with the JP Morgan statement in lieu of a receipt.

NOTE: A Missing Receipt Affidavit is not required for tips.
