





This thermostat senses when the room is empty, and lets the temperature float while you're away. The setpoint determines how much energy is used to heat or cool the room. Please do the following to save energy, save money, and ensure these units stay reliable and efficient:

- Turn this  to OFF when the window is open!
- Cooling – set the temperature no lower than 74 degrees 
- Heating – set the temperature no higher than 70 degrees 
- Fan –  use LOW setting for rooms, HIGH for lounges

Note: the room does not heat any faster by setting the temperature higher, this is not a gas pedal!
